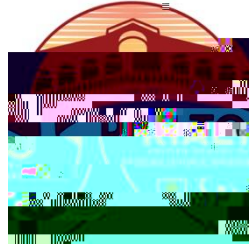

**RESOLUTION 20-21-25
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF
THE RIALTO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

March 15, 2021

WHEREAS, on or about March 23, 2020, the Rialto Unified School District, in response to the COVID-19 crisis, closed its schools and ceased operation of its athletic programs.

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2020, the California Department of Public Health (“CDPH”) released guidance for youth sports programs, outlining requirements and recommendations for safe youth sports programs. Under this guidance, the CDPH authorized physical conditioning, practice, skill-building, and training that can be conducted outdoors with six feet of physical distance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent and his designees will continue to meet to evaluate local, state and federal health orders relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, and will make recommendations and implement protocols necessary to comply with those orders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that should any portion of this Resolution be held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to tned
